After a recent conversation with OFHSA (the Federation our Association falls under) we learned better ways to protect your privacy, on our website, and in the distribution of meeting minutes.

We also learned our bylaws, written years ago, were never sent to the Federation for approval. After reviewing the guidelines we must follow, which they provided, the current executive had only a few paragraphs to decide on as an association, which are as follows; How many elected executive (reduced to 5); The amount the executive is authorized to spend without holding a general meeting (stays the same); The schedule of general meetings and the quorum required (stays the same).

We learned that **membership is required** for anyone who wants to have a vote going forward, on motions and elections, budget, and if you want to run for an elected position. Everyone will continue to be welcome, at general meetings, and everyone can continue to volunteer at events.

To proceed with what is required of us and giving those interested time to purchase memberships and have those memberships registered with OFHSA we need to start the process now. Our annual general meeting is not until June 11, at which time a proposed budget is passed and the new executive is elected.
